NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

- At the 73rd plenary meeting of its forty-third session, on 7 December 1988, the General Assembly adopted resolution 43/71, entitled, "Implementation of the Declaration on the Denuclearization of Africa". 1/
- 2. In paragraph 11 of resolution 43/71 B, the General Assembly:

"Commends the adoption by the Security Council of resolutions 558 (1984) of 13 December 1984 and 591 (1986) of 28 November 1986 on the question of South Africa, with a view to blocking the existing loopholes in the arms embargo so as to render it more effective and prohibiting, in particular, all forms of co-operation and collaboration with the racist régime of South Africa in the nuclear field."
