Organization of the sixtieth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Fourth report of the General Committee

1. At its 4th meeting, on 13 December 2005, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine (A/60/234) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Protracted conflicts in the Black Sea — South Caucasus region and their implications for international peace, security and development”

In this connection, the General Committee, by a vote of 5 to 3, with 17 abstentions, decided not to recommend the inclusion of the item in the agenda of the sixtieth session.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Costa Rica (A/60/235) for inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Follow-up to the recommendations of the Independent Inquiry Committee into the United Nations Oil-for-Food Programme”

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item, amended to read:

“Follow-up to the recommendations on administrative management and internal oversight of the Independent Inquiry Committee into the United Nations Oil-for-Food Programme”

(a) Be included in the agenda under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters);

(b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.
