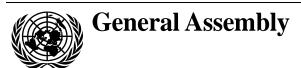

## Organization of the sixtieth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

## Fourth report of the General Committee

1. At its 4th meeting, on 13 December 2005, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine (A/60/234) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"Protracted conflicts in the Black Sea — South Caucasus region and their implications for international peace, security and development"

In this connection, the General Committee, by a vote of 5 to 3, with 17 abstentions, decided not to recommend the inclusion of the item in the agenda of the sixtieth session.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Costa Rica (A/60/235) for inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"Follow-up to the recommendations of the Independent Inquiry Committee into the United Nations Oil-for-Food Programme"

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item, amended to read:

"Follow-up to the recommendations on administrative management and internal oversight of the Independent Inquiry Committee into the United Nations Oil-for-Food Programme"

- (a) Be included in the agenda under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters);
  - (b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.
