## **Operational activities for development: operational activities for development of the United Nations system**

### **Report of the Second Committee\***

#### **I. Introduction**

1. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on agenda item 57 (see A/60/493, para. 2). Sub-item (a) was considered at the 33rd and 35th meetings on 2 and 9 December 2005. An account of the Committee's consideration of the item is given in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/60/SR.33 and 35).

#### **II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.2/60/L.30**

2. At its 33rd meeting, on 2 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Operational activities for development of the United Nations system" (A/C.2/60/L.30), submitted by Jamaica on behalf of the Group of 77 and China.

3. At its 35th meeting, on 9 December, the Committee was informed that the draft decision had no programme budget implications.

4. At the same meeting, the Committee was also informed that a recorded vote had been requested on the draft decision.

5. Also at the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.2/60/L.30 by a recorded vote of 157 to 1 (see para. 7). The voting was as follows:

6. After the adoption of the draft decision, a statement in explanation of vote was made after the vote by the representative of the United States of America (see A/C.2/60/SR.35).

### **III. Recommendation of the Second Committee**

7. The Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

#### **Operational activities for development of the United Nations system**

The General Assembly:

(a) Recalls its resolution 59/250 of 22 December 2004, as well as Economic and Social Council resolution 2005/7 of 20 July 2005 and other relevant resolutions;

(b) Takes note of the reports of the Secretary-General on comprehensive statistical data on operational activities for development of the United Nations

system for 2003<sup>1</sup> and on funding options and modalities for financing operational activities for development of the United Nations system,<sup>2</sup> and decides to request the Economic and Social Council at its substantive session of 2006 to further consider the above-mentioned reports in conjunction with paragraph 102 of General Assembly resolution 59/250 on the evaluation of the full implementation of that resolution;

(c) Also takes note of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit on some measures to improve overall performance of the United Nations system at the country level,<sup>3</sup> the related note by the Secretary-General transmitting the comments of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on that report<sup>4</sup> and the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the report of the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme on the activities of the United Nations Development Fund for Women.<sup>5</sup>
