NOTE VERBALE DATED 29 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's note PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) of 18 May 1978, has the honour to inform him that the "Law Prohibiting the Maintenance and Establishment of Economic Relations with the Republic of South Africa" was enacted in the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in 1963 and that, consequently, there do not exist any contractual or other arrangements between the two countries.
