NOTE VERBALE DATED 19 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF PORTUGAL TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the latter's note PO 230 SOAF, dated 10 November 1977, transmitting the text of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) on the question of South Africa, adopted on 4 November 1977.

This matter has received the most careful consideration from the Portuguese authorities. The Portuguese Government fully supports resolution 418 (1977) and intends to undertake all the necessary measures for its implementation.

On the other hand, the Portuguese Government will not fail to report to the Secretary-General all relevant information related to the aforementioned resolution.

The Permanent Representative of Portugal requests the Secretary-General to have the text of this note circulated as a document of the Security Council.
