

# Contingency fund: consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates

#### Report of the Secretary-General\*

- 1. The consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates, presented to the Fifth Committee, and falling under the guidelines for the contingency fund contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987, is herewith submitted. At this point, the Committee has yet to take formal action with regard to the approval of a number of specific programme budget implications and revised estimates before it. Accordingly, with regard to such programme budget implications and revised estimates, the statement takes as its starting point the value of the relevant items currently before the Committee for decision. The relevant recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions have also been taken into account in arriving at a consolidated statement of potential charges to the contingency fund. Programme budget implications and revised estimates, as amended by recommendations of the Advisory Committee, have been subjected to recosting based on the updated parameters applied to the regular budget (see A/60/599).
- 2. As regards conference servicing requirements, a review of overall conference serving requirements has been carried out to identify any possible additional absorption capacity. Given the significant absorption already taken into account in setting the level of additional conference servicing requirements related to new mandates, as well as the related recommendations of the Advisory Committee, further capacity for absorption is extremely limited. Nonetheless, an additional amount of \$689,800 has been identified for absorption.
- 3. After the above adjustments, as detailed in the annex to the present report, the consolidated amount of \$22,098,100 would be within the approved level of the

contingency fund of \$27,200,000 approved in General Assembly resolution 59/278 of 23 December 2004.

4. The Fifth Committee, in accordance with paragraph 5 of the annex to resolution 42/211, may proceed to recommend to the General Assembly the appropriation of the required amounts under the relevant sections of the programme budget as follows (in thousands of United States dollars):
