## **Report of the Fifth Committee**

1. At its 33rd and 36th meetings, on 19 and 23 December 2005, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/60/12) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/60/L.17 (as orally revised). At the 33rd meeting, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/60/7/Add.15). The draft decision submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations was before the Committee (see para. 3).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/60/SR.33 and 36).

## **Decision of the Fifth Committee**

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup> decides to

inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/C.3/60/L.17, as orally revised, additional resources in the total amount of \$9,519,300 would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007 as follows: section 9, Economic and social affairs (\$739,600); section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management (\$8,689,800); and section 28D, Office of Central Support Services (\$89,900). Appropriation of the amounts for the biennium 2006-2007 would be considered in accordance with the procedures for the use and operation of the contingency fund, at a subsequent stage, in the context of the review of the consolidated statement of all statements of programme budget implications and revised estimates as provided for in the procedures established by the Assembly in its resolutions 41/213 of 19 December 1986 and 42/211 of 21 December 1987 regarding the use and operation of the contingency fund.
