Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. The General Assembly, in resolution 35/81 of 5 December 1980, requested the Secretary-General to entrust to the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation the annual submission to the Assembly of comprehensive statistical information on the operational activities for development of the United Nations system. As indicated in paragraph 5 of the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the report of the Director-General for the comprehensive policy review of operational activities for development (A/38/258-E/1983/82), the most recent information pertaining to 1983 would be contained in an addendum to that policy report.
2. The addendum, prepared by the Director-General, is submitted herewith.
3. In accordance with paragraph 17 of General Assembly resolution 35/81, the addendum is being made available to the United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities.

I. RECENT TRENDS IN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES

1. In accordance with the request of the General Assembly in paragraph 17 of resolution 35/81 and paragraph 14 of resolution 36/199 of 17 December 1981, comprehensive statistical information concerning all operational activities for development is contained herein, on the same basis as that provided in the 1981 and 1982 annual reports, subject to the comments and explanations in the note on statistical information below.

Recent trends in contributions

2. Total contributions from Governments and other official and non-official sources to the development activities of the United Nations system, including therein all the funds and programmes of the United Nations, the operational activities of the specialized agencies and WFP, amounted to \$2.50 billion in 1982 compared to \$2.35 billion in 1981 (exclusive of cost-sharing and similar contributions). Contributions to the World Bank group and to IFAD reached the level of \$4.8 billion in 1982, compared to \$3.0 billion in 1981, the result of the effect of the timing of payments for the sixth replenishment of IDA, for the partial replenishment of IFAD and for capital subscriptions to the World Bank and to IFC. Summary details are provided in table 1. The pattern of resource flows to organizations is presented in chart A.

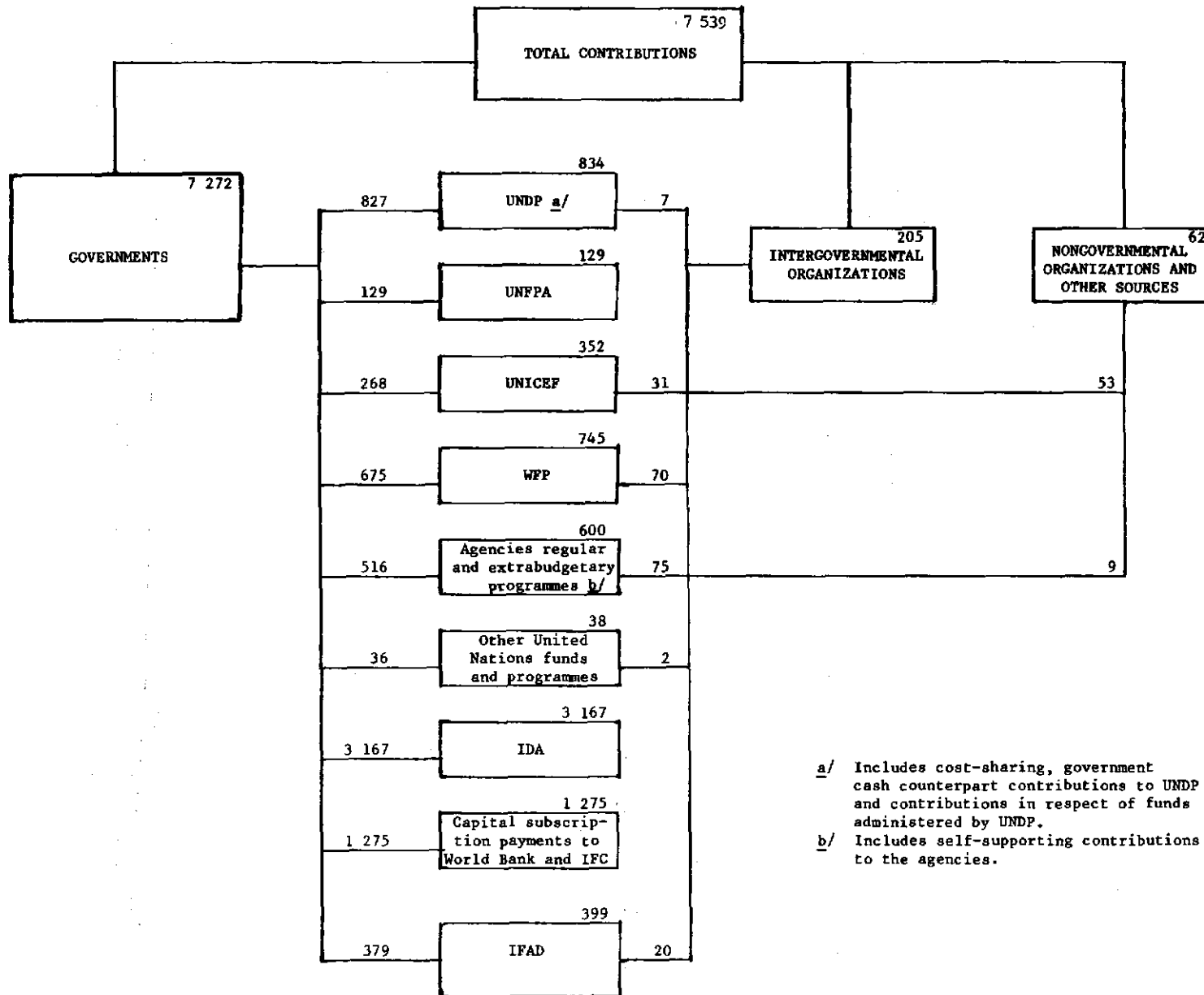

3. Contributions to the funds and programmes of the United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities grew in 1982 by 7.8 per cent in dollar terms, very largely the result of an increase in contributions from Governments to the supplementary funds of UNICEF. Most other funds and programmes participating in the Pledging Conference experienced stagnation, or at best a slight marginal increase, in the dollar value of contributions in 1982 so that, overall, contributions to the Pledging Conference stagnated in real terms. This occurred in spite of the record of a number of countries, which increased in real terms their contributions when expressed in their national currencies. Anticipated income of organizations was not fully materialized because of exchange rate changes between the time of the pledge or firm indication of contribution and the actual date of payment.

4. Contributions to the main programme of UNDP, which represents over 55 per cent of total contributions to the United Nations Pledging Conference, stagnated for the third consecutive year at around \$700 million. UNFPA experienced similar stagnation at around the \$130 million level. Total contributions to UNICEF grew by 34 per cent to \$321 million, primarily the result as noted above of a significant increase in contributions to supplementary resources. Over the last four years, total contributions (in current prices) to all the funds and programmes of the Pledging Conference have increased by 15 per cent, compared (again in current prices) to the growth of total ODA over the same period of 25 per cent.

5. Extrabudgetary contributions placed directly at the disposal of specialized agencies and other organizations for their operational activities continue to increase - at a declining rate - to reach the level of nearly \$300 million in 1982. Tables A-5, A-6 and A-7, which appear for the first time in the present series of reports, seek to throw further light on recent trends. In 1982, seven countries (in descending order of total contributions, Sweden, Netherlands, Denmark, Belgium, Norway, Federal Republic of Germany, and Italy) provided more than two thirds of total individual country contributions of \$212 million. International organizations (particularly the World Bank group and funds associated with OPEC countries) provided a total of \$75 million. Over 80 per cent of total contributions were received by four agencies, FAO, WHO, the ILO and UNESCO.

6. Contributions to WFP - including those for the International Emergency Food Reserve - have grown by 31 per cent since 1979 to reach the level of over \$745 million in 1982. By the end of 1982, 99 donors to WFP had pledged \$838 million for the regular resources of WFP for the biennium 1981/1982, 84 per cent of the target of \$1.0 billion set for the period.

7. Taken together, contributions to the funds and programmes of the United Nations, the operational activities of the specialized agencies and other organizations financed from regular and extrabudgetary contributions and to WFP - the organizations which constitute the focus of the policy report (see A/38/258-E/1983/82, para. 22) - increased from \$2.350 million in 1981 to \$2.509 million in 1982. This represents a growth of 6.7 per cent in nominal dollars, but it could mean stagnation in real terms if adjustments are made for increases in price levels. a/ The data confirm therefore the serious situation regarding the mobilization of resources for operational activities, to which the policy report drew attention (see A/38/258-E/1983/82, section IV-A). On present estimates, contributions to UNDP, UNFPA and UNICEF will show little or no growth in

1983. For WFP, total pledges for the 1983/1984 biennium amount to over \$1.0 billion towards the pledging target of \$1.2 billion.

8. Cost-sharing and other similar contributions from middle and higher income developing countries continue to grow in 1982 (see table 2). Such contributions have almost doubled since 1979, a reflection of the beneficial services developing countries obtain from the technical co-operation of the organizations of the system.

9. Data in respect of the World Bank group include information on contributions for the replenishment of IDA and on capital subscriptions payments by member countries to the World Bank and to IFC. Year to year changes reflect both the bunching of payments to IDA - which are recorded here, in accordance with accepted definitions, on a note deposit basis - and the timing of subscription payments. Both factors significantly affected the increase of contributions to the World Bank group in 1982, in particular the large payments by certain major contributors to IDA and the subscription payments by many countries to the World Bank and IFC. Over the two-year period, 1981-1982, the effect of the timing of payments is much reduced.

10. A number of countries paid in 1982 in full or in part their contributions to IFAD under the first replenishment agreement. Major pledges remain, however, to be ratified within the replenishment period. Data in respect of IDA and of IFAD presented in this addendum do not reflect any change in the serious resource mobilization situation facing both organizations described in paragraphs 71 and 72 of the policy report (A/38/258-E/1983/82).

11. Contributions to operational activities do not fully reflect the capacity of countries to contribute. For example, drawing upon the data in table A-4 which reflects the period 1981-1982, of the 10 countries making the largest contributions in volume terms, three (Canada, the Netherlands, Sweden) are included among the top 10 largest contributors in per capita terms and in terms of contributions as a proportion of GNP (see table 3). The performance of a number of smaller donors, including oil exporting developing countries, appears to be better than that of some larger donors. The 1982 performance of three non-oil exporting developing countries (i.e., Guyana, Swaziland and Vanuatu) reflects capital subscription

payments to the World Bank group noted above. It may also be noted that there is little comparison between the share of each major contributing country in the total volume of contributions and its share in the assessment scale for the United Nations regular budget.

12. As noted in previous reports, contributions for operational activities reflect differing attitudes among donors to ODA in general and differing preferences between bilateral and multilateral channels. b/ Members of the Development Assistance Committee of OECD - for whom the ODA/GNP ratio in 1981 was 0.35 per cent - provide about 85 per cent of total resources for the system's operational activities. The data presented in table A-5 for the period 1975-1982 show that, while the proportion of total DAC ODA channelled through the multilateral institutions of the United Nations system - including the World Bank group - has grown at rates faster than that for overall ODA, there are significant variations among individual DAC member countries. Four countries, comprising 8 per cent of DAC ODA, channelled one third of their ODA through the system; seven countries comprising 50 per cent of DAC ODA, channelled between one fifth and one third; and six countries, comprising 42 per cent of DAC ODA, channelled less than one fifth. By 1982, about 22 per cent of total DAC ODA was being channelled through the system.

13. Aid provided by the member countries of OPEC amounted to 1.46 per cent of their aggregate GNP in 1981. About one eighth is channelled through multilateral institutions, mainly the Arab aid agencies and the OPEC Fund for International Development. The share of total aid from OPEC member countries channelled through the organizations of the United Nations system is generally less than 5 per cent of total annual OPEC aid disbursements. However, that participation may increase through the activities of the Arab Gulf Programme for the United Nations Development Organizations (AGFUND), established in 1981.

14. Contributions for refugee, humanitarian, special economic assistance programmes and disaster relief activities - which are not included in the above data - amounted to \$574 million in 1982, a slight drop from the level obtained in 1981 of \$625 million. No firm conclusions can be drawn from year to year changes in total contributions for such activities. It is nevertheless desirable that the international community maintain its traditionally high level of support in view of the urgent refugee and humanitarian problems that exist throughout the world.

Recent trends in expenditures

15. Flows of concessional and non-concessional resources (on a net transfer basis) for operational activities for development, including technical co-operation, commodity and capital assistance undertaken by organizations of the United Nations system amounted to \$6.6 billion in 1982 compared to \$6.0 billion in 1981 (see table 4). Chart B depicts the composition of this total flow. It may be noted that by far the greater share of operational activities went directly to developing countries in support of national development programmes (about 93 per cent). The balance (about 7 per cent) was directed towards operational activities carried out on a regional, interregional and global basis. The share of total concessional resources (that is, grants and concessional loans) amounted to 56 per cent of the total net transfer of resources through the system, compared to 64 per cent in 1981.

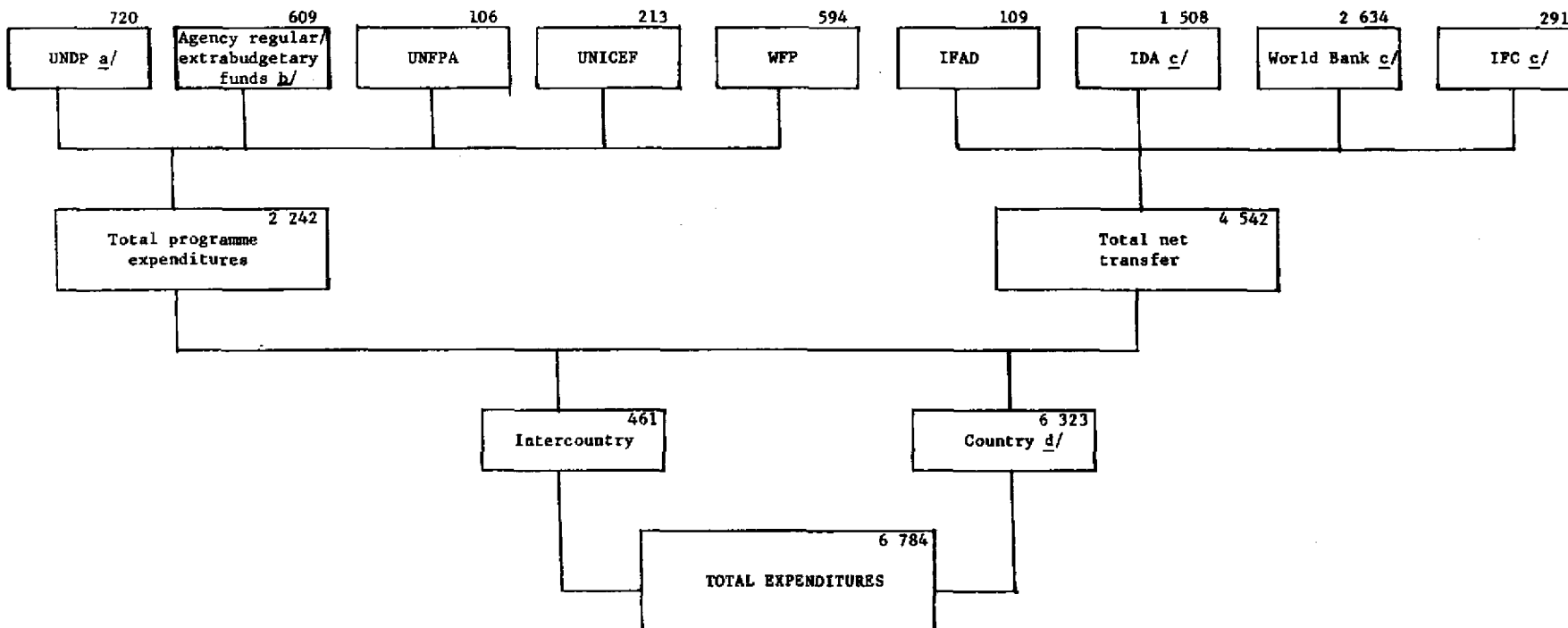

16. Grant-financed expenditures (that is, those undertaken by the organizations of the system other than the World Bank group and IFAD) c/ amounted to \$2,096 million in 1982 compared to \$2,159 million in 1981, a decline of about 3 per cent in nominal dollar terms. The main reason for the overall decline in the dollar value of expenditures was the drop in UNDP main programme expenditures by \$80 million to a level of \$590 million. WFP was able to increase its programme expenditures by about 10 per cent in 1982, to reach the level of \$594 million. Almost all other organizations experienced little or no increase. Technical co-operation expenditures financed from regular budgets declined in 1982. Overall per capita expenditures on operational activities also declined in 1982 after years of sustained increases.

17. Nearly two fifths of system-wide expenditures on technical co-operation take place in two sectors - health, 19.5 per cent, and agriculture, forestry and fisheries, 18.0 per cent (see table B-6) d/. Another two thirds take place in four sectors, namely, natural resources (9.8 per cent), transport and communication (9.0 per cent), general development, planning and statistics (8.4 per cent) and population (7.7 per cent). As these figures suggest, the sectoral distribution of expenditures is heavily influenced by both the source of funding (i.e., regular or extrabudgetary) and by the organizations involved. Given the relative size of the WHO regular budget and its concentration on technical co-operation, it is therefore to be expected that regular budget financed technical co-operation expenditures are dominated by the health sector. UNDP IPF-financed expenditures - which reflect an aggregation of developing country priorities - are concentrated in such sectors as agriculture, forestry and fisheries (25 per cent) and transport and communications, general development issues and natural resources (each 13 per cent). e/

18. An overview of the distribution of grant-financed expenditures within the system is provided in table B-3 which lists organizational entities engaged in operational activities and indicates their expenditures by main source of funding. Nearly 46 per cent of the technical co-operation activities (that is, all grant-financed activities other than those financed by UNICEF and WFP and including cost-sharing and similiar expenditures) of the system were financed by UNDP. Extrabudgetary resources placed at the disposal of the specialized agencies and other organizations were the next single most important source of funding, amounting to 29 per cent. Two organizations (FAO and WHO) accounted for nearly 38 per cent of total expenditures on technical co-operation, followed by the Department of Technical Co-operation for Development of the United Nations Secretariat, the ILO, UNIDO, UNESCO and the Office for Projects Execution of UNDP.

19. Information on the flow of concessional resources to various income groupings of developing countries and to the developing regions is provided in tables B-4 and B-5. The system's operational activities reflect both universality of participation and a focus on least developed and other low-income countries. Overall, countries with a per capita GNP of less than \$500 accounted for 70 per cent of grant-financed operational activities: the proportion ranges from a high of 85 per cent in the case of UNICEF to 50 per cent in the case of expenditures financed from agency regular and extrabudgetary programmes. These proportions decrease as per capita income increases. There is a fairly even distribution of resource flows among the developing regions of the world on a per capita basis. In contrast, two thirds of expenditures financed from

cost-sharing and similiar contributions take place in developing countries with per capita income greater than \$2,500.

20. In contrast to flows through the system, bilateral ODA flows from the DAC member countries have a less pronounced concentration on the least developed and other low-income countries as slightly less than one half of DAC bilateral ODA is channelled to countries with per capita GNP below \$500. Some 36 per cent of the operational activities of the United Nations system take place in least developed countries, compared to about 20 per cent of DAC bilateral ODA.

21. Data on the regional distribution of expenditures, which are provided in table 5, show that four fifths of country and regional activities take place in two regions - Africa and Asia and the Pacific. When population is taken into account, the data reveal a more equitable distribution among all regions, according to need and level of development.

22. Expenditures financed from cost-sharing and other similar contributions have increased in recent years to reach the level of \$140 million in 1982. UNDP cost-sharing expenditures tend to correspond broadly to the sectoral distribution of country programmes. Unilateral or self-supporting expenditures of the specialized agencies appear to be concentrated in such sectors as transport and communications (34 per cent) and culture (22 per cent).

23. Total gross disbursements by the World Bank group (including IDA and IFC) amounted to \$8.9 billion, net disbursements to \$6.8 billion and net transfers to \$4.4 billion. Gross disbursements by the World Bank and IDA on technical co-operation embodied in their lending programmes (i.e., on training and consultants) reached the level of \$731 million in 1982, a doubling since 1978. As reflected in the policy report (A/38/258-E/1983/82, paras. 63 and 64), World Bank

borrowers are disbursing parts of loan funds earmarked for technical co-operation by using the services of organizations in the system.

24. Total United Nations system-wide expenditures on technical co-operation amounted to \$2.2 billion in 1982, compared to \$2.0 billion in 1981, including the technical co-operation embodied in the World Bank lending operations. The share of UNDP in total system-wide grant-financed technical co-operation (i.e., exclusive of World Bank operations) amounted to 46 per cent in 1982, compared to 50 per cent in 1981.

25. The summary data provided above do not include expenditures on refugee, humanitarian and disaster relief assistance. Expenditures on these activities amounted to \$621 million in 1982, compared to \$648 million in 1981. The major share of these expenditures is financed by UNHCR (\$421.1 million in 1982) and by UNWRA, which in 1982 experienced a significant increase in activities arising out of developments in Lebanon.

26. Total ODA transferred through the organizations of the system to developing countries amounted to \$4.5 billion in 1982, or about 13 per cent of total developing country ODA receipts. The United Nations system ODA comprises expenditures and disbursements from all organizations, including IDA, IFAD, the refugee, humanitarian and related activities and the programmes of the Environment Fund of UNEP. It does not include the cost-sharing and self-supporting contributions to organizations, and the programme expenditures financed therefrom, since such contributions do not represent a transfer from one country to another. Expenditures on administrative and programme support costs (see below) also do not qualify as ODA and are therefore excluded from the above figure.

Expenditures on administrative and programme support costs

27. Such data as are currently available on administrative and programme support costs are contained in table 6, together with comparable data for 1981. Data on programme outlays associated with the levels of administrative and support costs are contained in table B-1.

28. Issues associated with information on the level of administrative and programme support costs were addressed in the policy report (see A/38/258-E/1983/82, paras. 132-140). Year to year changes in costs suggested in table 6 do not in themselves reveal significant trends. It is recognized, however, that fuller information and analysis needs to be provided on administrative and support costs. Subsequent reports of the Director-General will seek to respond to the concerns of Member States on this matter, bearing in mind the timing of the introduction of the UNDP ex post facto reporting system.

29. Information on regular budget contributions to technical co-operation activities, including information on the excess of support costs over reimbursements, is contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on administrative and budgetary co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and IAEA and in the financial statement and accounts of those organizations engaged in operational activities.

II. NOTE ON STATISTICAL INFORMATION AND STATISTICAL TABLES

30. Coverage, definition and presentation of, as well as sources for, the statistical information are identical to the first and second annual reports, with the following additions and explanations.

Coverage

31. The General Assembly, in paragraph 6 of resolution 37/142 of 17 December 1982, requested Member States to announce their voluntary contributions early, if possible at the annual United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities. Accordingly, data in respect of UNITAR are included in table A-2,

which also includes information on special purpose and other similar contributions to UNDP contained in the UNDP financial statement and accounts.

32. The following tables have been added to the statistical series:

(a) Tables A-6, A-7 and A-8, with information on extrabudgetary contributions placed directly at the disposal of organizations. Table A-6 provides such data for 1982, by major contributing country and by organization; table A-7 provides the data for 1979-1982, by major contributing country; and table A-8 provides the same data, for the same period, by organization;

(b) Table B-6 provides data on the sectoral distribution of technical co-operation expenditures, for 1982.

33. The preparation of tables A-6 to A-8 entailed minor modifications to the 1979-1981 data on voluntary contributions for the operational activities of the specialized agencies and other organizations. Updated data for this item of contributions have been included in the present report (see table A-1, row II.7).

34. Previous reports did not include data in respect of contributions to the International Emergency Food Reserve of WFP. Such data have been included in table A-1 (see footnote g). The relevant data in table 5 of the policy report (A/38/258-E/1983/82) should therefore be adjusted accordingly. See also table A-3, footnote d.

Definitions

35. As in previous reports, data on contributions refer exclusively to contributions received or collected or payments made by Governments and other sources to organizations. Data on expenditures and disbursements represent the support provided by organizations to the programmes and projects of developing countries, exclusive of administrative, programme and other support costs. For the purposes of the present report, all net disbursements by IFAD (see table B-2) are assumed to have been made on concessional terms. The category of least developed countries does not include the five countries added by the General Assembly in its resolution 37/133 of 17 December 1982 to the official list of least developed countries. While UNICEF and WFP carry out activities which are of a humanitarian and emergency character, all data relating to their operations are included under the rubric of operational activities for development. Net disbursements represent gross disbursements less repayment of principal. Net transfers represent net disbursements less interest and other charges.

36. For information on the sources of data, see paragraph 45 of the first annual report (A/36/478, annex) and the footnotes to the tables.

37. The data represent final figures for 1982. Any revisions or updating that may later prove necessary will be brought to the attention of the General Assembly in an appropriate manner.

Notes
