NOTE VERBALE DATED 16 DECEMBER 1977 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF BELGIUM TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations has the honour to refer to the letter of the Secretary-General of the United Nations dated 10 November 1977, communicating the text of resolution 418 (1977) on the "Question of South Africa", which was adopted by the Security Council on 4 November 1977.

The communication has been given special attention by the Belgian authorities, which intend to ensure rigorous implementation of resolution 418 (1977). Belgium's commitment to comply with the recent obligatory measures of the Security Council is consistent with the measures which Belgium has long been applying voluntarily with regard to an embargo on the delivery of weapons to South Africa.

The Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations requests the Secretary-General to have the text of this note circulated as a Security Council document.
