LETTER DATED 29 NOVEMBER 1977 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit herewith the text of resolution 32/9 D* on the situation in Namibia resulting from the illegal occupation of the Territory by South Africa, adopted by the General Assembly at its 57th plenary meeting on 4 November 1977.

In paragraph 32 of this resolution, the General Assembly

"Urges the Security Council to take up again the question of Namibia, which is still on its agenda, and to consider the application of sanctions against South Africa in accordance with Chapter VII of the Charter".
