Proposed Addition to the Report of the Commission

The Commission received, in private meeting, a confidential list of communications received concerning human rights compiled by the Secretary-General, together with the Report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Communications composed of the Representatives of Chile, France, Lebanon, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the United States of America.

The Commission recommended that the Economic and Social Council request the Secretary-General, in the future, to ask the governments sending replies to communications brought to their attention in accordance with paragraph (e) of Resolution 75 (V) of the Economic and Social Council whether they wish their replies to be transmitted to the Commission on Human Rights in summary form, or presented in full as restricted or unrestricted documents.
