United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland:
revised draft resolution

The Security Council,

Taking note of the letters to the President of the Security Council dated 1 September (S/12393) and 8 September 1977 (S/12395) from the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,

Noting also the invitation to the Secretary-General, in the letter dated 23 September 1977 (S/12402) to the President of the Security Council from the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom, to appoint a representative,

Having heard the statement made by Mr. Joshua Nkomo, Co-leader of the Patriotic Front of Zimbabwe,

1. Requests the Secretary-General to appoint, in consultation with the Security Council members, a representative to enter into discussions, with the British Resident Commissioner designate and with all the parties, concerning the military and associated arrangements that are considered necessary to effect the transition to majority rule in Southern Rhodesia;

2. Further requests the Secretary-General to transmit a report on the result of these discussions to the Security Council as soon as possible;

3. Calls upon all parties to co-operate with the representative of the Secretary-General in the conduct of the discussions referred to in paragraph 1 of this resolution.
