**Approved resources for peacekeeping operations  
for the period from 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006**

**Note by the Secretary-General**

1. Pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution 49/233 A, information on the approved resources for peacekeeping operations, inclusive of requirements for the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi, Italy, and the support account for peacekeeping operations, for the period from 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006 was provided in my note of 29 June 2005 (A/C.5/59/34).
2. In accordance with established practice, the present note has been prepared to reflect further financing actions taken by the General Assembly in the regular part of its sixtieth session in respect of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH), the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUC), the United Nations Mission in the Sudan (UNMIS) and the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire (UNOCI).
3. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 49/233 A, consolidated information on the proposed budgetary requirements for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2006 to 30 June 2007 will be submitted to the Assembly in May 2006.
