DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Decisions taken by the Commission on Human Rights as of 23 May 1949

Article 5

(To be drafted by a Sub-Committee composed of the representatives of Chile, China, Denmark, France, Lebanon, the USSR, the United Kingdom and the United States of America).

Article 6

(To be referred to the World Health Organization. This article will become Article 7 in the new draft).

Article 7

"No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment." (This article will become Article $\underline{6}$ in the new draft).

Article 8

"1. No one shall be held in slavery; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms."

(The rest of this article is to be drafted by a Sub-Committee composed of the representatives of France, Guatemala, India, Lebanon, the Philippines, the USSR, the United Kingdom and the United States of America).

Article 9

- "1. No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest or detention.
- 2. No one shall be deprived of his liberty except on such grounds and in accordance with such procedure as established by law."

 (It was decided that certain proposals on Article 2 which were not accepted by the Commission would nevertheless be included in the Commission's report).
