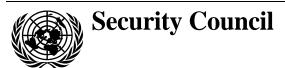

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo

Note verbale dated 13 February 2006 from the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo and, following the adoption of resolution 1649 (2005), by which, among other determinations, the Council decided to expand the list of individuals subject to the provisions of paragraphs 13 to 16 of resolution 1596 (2005), has the honour to inform the Committee that the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil has adopted the necessary measures in compliance with Security Council resolution 1649 (2005).

Security Council resolution 1649 (2005) was incorporated into national legislation by Decree 5696 of 7 February 2006. In keeping with that decree, the Brazilian authorities must comply, within the limits of their duties and powers, with the provisions related to the arms embargo, asset freeze and travel ban.
