DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Article 20

Joint United States of America - France - Philippines Proposal

Everyone is entitled to equal protection of the law in the enjoyment of all the rights and freedoms defined in this Covenant, without discrimination of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.

Everyone is entitled to equal protection against any discrimination in violation of this Covenant and against any incitement to such discrimination.
