LETTER DATED 25 OCTOBER 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LIBYAN ARAB JAMAHIRIYA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I wish to draw your attention to the events currently taking place in Grenada, namely, the large-scale military invasion of Grenadian territory by the United States of America, its violation of Grenadian sovereignty and its blatant intervention in the internal affairs of that non-aligned country.

This blatant aggression against a State member of the Non-Aligned Movement represents another link in the chain of acts of aggression and invasion carried out by the United States Administration against the small non-aligned peoples.

The Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, in condemning this aggression and this invasion, stresses the need for the Council to take rigorous measures to repulse and halt the aggression and to secure the immediate withdrawal of the invading American forces. In this connection, it supports the request of Nicaragua for the convening of an urgent meeting of the Council to consider this question.
