1. Pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolutions 1982/67 and 1985/71, the Council is to elect, at its resumed organizational session for 2006, 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2007 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2006 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Argentina, Benin, Brazil, Burundi, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Malaysia, Mexico, Nigeria, Pakistan, Poland, Thailand and Tunisia. There are six vacancies on the Working Group that were not filled for members whose terms would expire on 31 December 2008.
2. The members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
 - Four seats from African States;
 - Four members from Asian States;
 - Two members from Eastern European States;
 - Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States.
3. The composition of the Working Group in 2006 is given in the annex below.
