LETTER DATED 25 OCTOBER 1983 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES OF
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SAINT LUCIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to address you, on behalf of the Government of Saint Lucia, requesting that the Security Council delay its decision to deal with the item - situation in Grenada, since the Regional Organization, the Organization of American States will be dealing with the matter at a meeting to be held tomorrow 26 October 1983.

This request, Excellency, is made in keeping with Article 52 of the Charter of the United Nations, in an attempt to obtain a regional solution to the problem in Grenada. I request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
