- 1. Pursuant to paragraph 4 of its resolution 2003/57 of 24 July 2003, the Economic and Social Council is to elect, at its resumed substantive session for 2006, 10 members of the Executive Board of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2007.
