
Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 37th, 38th and 40th meetings, on 6, 9 and 15 March 2006, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/60/28) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/60/L.48. At the 37th meeting, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/60/7/Add.34).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/60/SR.37, 38 and 40).

3. Following informal consultations conducted by the representative of Ireland, on behalf of the Chairman, the Committee adopted an oral decision (see para. 4).



Decision of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,² decides to inform the General Assembly that should it adopt draft resolution A/60/L.48, there would be need for an additional appropriation of \$4,328,700 (net), subject to the procedures governing the use and operation of the contingency fund.
