REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF FRANCE ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 24 August 1956 from the chargé d'affaires a.i. of the permanent mission of France to the United Nations, transmitting credentials signed on 25 June 1956 by the President of the Republic of France appointing M. Bernard Cornut-Gentille as permanent representative of France on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
