EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

In accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure, the first item to be considered is the **adoption** of the agenda.

2. ACTIVITIES OF UNECE BODIES OF INTEREST TO THE WORKING PARTY

(a) <u>Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)</u>

The sixty-first session of the Economic Commission for Europe was held in Geneva from 20-24 February 2006.

The Working Party may wish **to be informed** about the decisions taken by the Commission at its sixty-first session, concerning such questions as the UNECE reform, major policy directions in UNECE's work, and UNECE technical assistance.

(b) <u>Inland Transport Committee and its subsidiary bodies</u>

The Inland Transport Committee (ITC) held its sixty-eighth session in Geneva from 7-9 February 2006.

The Working Party may wish **to be informed** about matters of interest considered by the Committee, in particular in the work area of transport statistics of the Committee's report (ECE/TRANS/166).

(c) Transport, Health and Environment Pan-European Programme (THE PEP)
