The title of the Regulation, amend to read:
"UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF POWER-DRIVEN VEHICLE'S SEALED-BEAM HEADLAMPS (SB) FOR EMITTING AN EUROPEAN ASYMMETRICAL PASSING BEAM OR A DRIVING BEAM OR BOTH"

Paragraph 1., amend to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote $\underline{2} /$ and a new footnote $2 / /$ ):
"1. SCOPE 1/
This Regulation applies to headlamps for vehicles of categories $\mathrm{M}, \mathrm{N}$, and $\mathrm{T} \underline{2} /$.
$\underline{1 /} \quad$ As defined in Annex 7 to the Consolidated Resolution on the Construction of Vehicles (R.E.3), (document TRANS/WP.29/78/Rev.1/Amend. 2 as last amended by Amend.4)."
