LETTER DATED 18 FEBRUARY 1965 FROM THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE GAMBIA
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On behalf of the Government of the Gambia, and in my capacity as Prime Minister, I have the honour to inform you that the Gambia having today attained independence, wishes herewith to make application for membership of the United Nations, with all the rights and duties attached thereto.

I should accordingly be grateful if this application could be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting. For this purpose, I attach a declaration made in pursuance of Rule 58 of the Council's Rules of Procedure.
