LETTER DATED 20 FEBRUARY 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF HUNGARY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government, I have the honour to transmit hereby to you the resolution of the National Assembly of the Hungarian People's Republic of 12 February 1965, adopted on the recent acts of aggression committed by the United States against the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam.

I have the honour to request you to have the above-mentioned resolution circulated as an official document of the Security Council.

The National Assembly has received the message of the Government of the fraternal Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam addressed to the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic, which gives an account of the recent American aggressive acts, more serious than ever before, directed against the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam and against South Viet-Nam, and which appeals for international solidarity to curb the imperialist aggression, to ensure the implementation of the Geneva Agreements to safeguard peace in Indo-China and in South East Asia.

The National Assembly and the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic condemn with profound indignation these new criminal acts of the United States. While attempting to evade the increasing pressure of the South Vietnamese people for peace and freedom the American imperialism is stepping up and escalating its "mad war" by renewed barbarous attacks, thus gravely endangering peace in South East Asia and in the whole world.

The Hungarian people, alongside with all peace-loving peoples of the world, considers the attacks against the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam, the war waged against South Vietnamese people, the attempts to recruit mercenaries from South Korea and Latin America, constituting a wanton aggression and the most sinister crimes in flagrant violation of the norms of international law and of humanitarianism.

Endorsing the appeal of the Government of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam the National Assembly assures the Vietnamese people, who endured so much suffering, of its full solidarity and emphatically protests against the continuous violation of the Geneva Agreements as well as the incessant provocations against the Vietnamese people. It demands furthermore that the United States immediately put an end to its armed attacks against the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam, stop its war against the people of South Viet-Nam, liquidate its military bases, withdraw its troops from that region, and duly respect the Geneva Agreements of 1954 and of 1962. The National Assembly supports all proposals aiming at the convocation of a new Geneva Conference for the sake of restoring peace and security in South East Asia.

Our Government and people are deeply convinced that despite all the manoeuvres of imperialism, the undaunted and sacred fight of the Vietnamese people, waged for the complete liberation and unification of their fatherland will end with complete victory.
