Corrigendum

In document E/CN.4/353/Add.6, which contains the comments and proposals of the Netherlands Government on the draft International Covenant on Human Rights and Measures of Implementation, two typographical errors should be corrected.

On page 1, fourth line from bottom, between the words "extremely" and "task," the word "difficult" should be inserted.

On page 1, last line, the word "expensive" should be changed to "extensive."

Thus corrected, the two sentences should read:

"Owing to these facts the unification of the formulation of the human rights, on which depends in principle all international safeguarding of these rights, will be an extremely difficult task which can only gradually be carried out. In the opinion of the Netherlands Government it should be borne in mind that the very nature of these human rights requires that all efforts should be aimed at attaining the most extensive sphere of application of international protection."
