THE INDIA-PAKISTAN QUESTION

Colombia: amendments to the joint draft resolution submitted by
Australia, Cuba, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
and the United States of America (S/3787)

1. Replace the preamble by the following text:

"The Security Council,

Recalling its previous resolutions and the letter addressed to
to the President of the U.N.C.I.P. on 20 December 1948,".

2. Amend paragraph 1 of the operative part to read as follows:

"Requests the President of the Security Council, the
representative of Sweden, to examine with the Governments of
India and Pakistan proposals, which, in his opinion are likely
to contribute to the achievement of the provisions contemplated
in the resolutions of 13 August 1948, and 5 January 1949, of
the U.N.C.I.P. or to the establishment of other conditions for
progress towards the settlement of the problem, bearing in mind
the statements of the representatives of the Governments of India
and Pakistan; the proposals for the use of a temporary U.N.
Force, if accepted by the parties, or the possibility to refer
the problem to the International Court of Justice,".

3. In the paragraph 3 of the operative part, replace the last words by
the following text:

"if possible not later than 15 April 1957."
