DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

United States of America: Revised proposal for paragraph 1 of Article 13

"The press and public may be excluded from all or part of a trial in the interest of morals, public order or national security, or where the interest of juveniles so requires, or to the extent strictly necessary in the opinion of the court in special circumstances where publicity would prejudice the interest of justice; but the judgment shall be pronounced publicly except where the interest of juveniles otherwise requires."
