DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS (E/1371)

France and Belgium: Amendment to paragraph 3 of Article 13

In any case where by a final decision a person has been convicted of a criminal offence and where subsequently a new or newly discovered fact appears which shows conclusively that there has been a miscarriage of justice, the person who has suffered punishment as a result of such conviction shall be compensated. This compensation shall be awarded to the heirs of a person executed by virtue of an erroneous sentence.
