LETTER DATED 20 APRIL 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In a letter addressed to Your Excellency on 7 April 1965, $\frac{1}{}$ the Chargé d'Affaires of Greece claimed that a violation of Greek air space by Turkish aircraft has taken place on 6 April 1965.

This is obviously another example of trumped-up charges on the part of Greece against Turkey, as a thorough investigation carried out by the competent Turkish authorities has shown that the allegation mentioned in the Greek Chargé d'Affaires' letter is entirely without foundation.

I shall be grateful if Your Excellency would kindly have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
