DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Denmark, Egypt, France and Lebanon: draft resolution concerning
economic, social and cultural rights

The Commission on Human Rights

Being resolved to prepare at this juncture its programme of work for 1951, with a view to securing to each person the enjoyment of the economic, social and cultural rights set forth in Articles 22 to 27 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,

Taking note of the survey prepared by the Secretary-General regarding the activities of other bodies of the United Nations and of the specialized agencies in matters within the scope of the said articles,

Considering the significance of the measures already taken or planned to be taken by such bodies and by the specialized agencies, as well as the desirability of promoting and supplementing their activities,

Accepts with gratitude the offers made by ITO and UNESCO to assist the Commission in the preparation of draft texts to be considered at its next session, and

Requests the Secretary-General to take the necessary steps to secure similar co-operation from other United Nations organs and the specialized agencies, and requests him to submit to the Commission, before its first session in 1951, the draft texts so received together with such other documentary material as he may consider advisable.
