COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS Sixth session

DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS

United Kingdom: Draft resolution

The Commission on Human Rights,

Having adopted a Draft Covenant on Human Rights with Draft Measures of Implementation,

Considering that during the deliberations of the Commission in its sixth session considerable divergences of opinion have been expressed on the measures now proposed, and that on some fundamental problem generally acceptable solutions have not been found, and

Considering that a Covenant and measures of implementation which do not receive a full measures of support will not facilitate the effective application of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

Recommends to the Economic and Social Council to examine these draft proposals and to determine, in the light of these circumstances, whether the Draft Covenant and Draft Measures of Implementation should be submitted to the fifth General Assembly, or whether new instructions should be given to the Commission on Human Rights on the future scope and method of their work.
