LETTER DATED 15 JULY 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following my letter No. P3365-95 of 21 June 1965, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that my Government has lodged formal protests with the Turkish Government about the following new violations of Greek air space, which took place on 13 July 1965:

I. At 08:24 hours, two Turkish jet aircraft were spotted over the island of Lesbos at point $38^{\circ}08'$ north - $26^{\circ}29'$ east. After 3 minutes they left through point $38^{\circ}55'$ north - $26^{\circ}58'$ east.

II. At 08:37 hours two Turkish jet aircraft penetrated the Greek air space at point $38^{\circ}59'$ north - $26^{\circ}38'$ east, overflowed the Lesbos area for 3 minutes and left through point $38^{\circ}54'$ north - $29^{\circ}30'$ east.

III. At 08:50 hours two Turkish jet aircraft were spotted over the area of the island of Lesbos, at point $19^{\circ}09'$ north - $26^{\circ}31'$ east. After 3 minutes they left through point $38^{\circ}56'$ north - $26^{\circ}32'$ east.

All the above overflights were performed at an altitude of 22,000 feet and a speed of 450 mph.

IV. On 14 July 1965, at 12:50 hours a Turkish airplane overflowed the north-eastern coast of Lesbos (point $39^{\circ}20'$ north - $26^{\circ}25'$ east) at an altitude of 2,000 feet in a NW-SE direction.

I would appreciate it if Your Excellency would have this letter reproduced as a document of the Security Council.
