LETTER DATED 21 JULY 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA ADDRESSED TO THE FRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

With reference to the letter dated 7 June 1965, addressed by the Permanent Representative of Pakistan (document No. S/6423), I have been instructed by my Government to state that in view of other developments it is no longer necessary to dwell at length again on the merits of the Pakistan contention concerning the correct alignment of the boundaries of Sind (Pakistan).

My Government earnestly hopes that the agreement referred to in the preceding paragraph will ultimately lead to a final settlement of differences between the two Governments on this question.

I shall be grateful if this communication is circulated to the members of the Security Council.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
