Comments on options to facilitate global harmonization

Transmitted by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)

Background

- 1. At the twentieth meeting of the ICAO Dangerous Goods Panel (DGP/20), a paper based on ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2005/20 together with the report of the informal discussion which took place at the twenty-seventh session was discussed.
- 2. A number of possible areas where harmonization could be improved were considered e.g. using the UN special provision numbering for those special provisions which are completely in alignment with the equivalent UN special provision and/or identifying other special provisions which have been modified or are unique for air transport.
- 3. The meeting agreed that this was an effort which should definitely be supported by ICAO. However, it was not considered feasible to look into it in detail at DGP/20. It was agreed that the matter should be pursued actively as part of its work programme during the next biennium.
