CAFLE DATED 28 JULY 1965 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

In accordance with Article 54 of the Charter of the United Nations, I have the honour to transmit to you for the information of the Security Council the text of cable No. 416 dated 27 July, which was sent to me by the Director of CAS Secretariat Services in the Dominican Republic:

"Santo Domingo, 27 July 1965

"No. 416

"Dr. José A. Mora Secretary-General of the OAS Pan-American Union Washington, D.C.

"There was no violation of the cease-fire on 26 July.

"The Commission on Human Rights received various persons who submitted complaints regarding alleged violations of human rights. The Government of National Reconstruction reported that from 23 July contacts a screening committee will be operating in <u>La Victoria</u> penitentiary. The Commission has been informed that this committee will be empowered 'to free those persons against whom there are no charges'. Mrs. Angela Acuna de Chacon visited the San Isidro air base to check whether there were any political prisoners.
