CABLE DATED 29 JULY 1965 FROM THE SECRETARY GUNLRAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED MATIONS

In accordance with Article 54 of the Charter of the United Mations, I have the honour to transmit to you for the information of the Security Council the text of cable No. 424 dated 26 July, which was sent to me by the Director of OAS Secretariat Services in the Dominican Republic:

"Santo Domingo, 28 July 1965

"No. 424

"Dr. José A. Mora Secretary General of OAS Pan-American Union Washington, D.C.

"1. The Inter-American Peace Force announces that there were no attacks on the 27th.

"2. The Commission on Human Rights visited La Victoria penitentiary, where the authorities informed it that the screening committee had begun operating. It urged the authorities to take the necessary steps to solve the problem of detainees against whom there are no charges. The Commission sent the screening committee a list of almost 200 civilian political prisoners at La Victoria who were duly interviewed by the Commission; some of these have been waiting for more than two months for a decision. This afternoon the representative of the Commission, Angela Acuna de Chacon, a lawyer, accompanied by Dr. Zanotti, had an interview with General Imbert. During the day the Commission received forty-three persons who put before it problems concerning violations of human rights.
