REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF
THE REPRESENTATIVE OF COLOMBIA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a cablegram dated 11 July 1957 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Colombia, stating that Dr. Alfonso Araujo has been appointed representative of Colombia on the Security Council.^{1/}

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

^{1/} Until Dr. Alfonso Araujo assumes his office, Ambassador Francisco Urrutia will continue as representative of Colombia on the Security Council.
