- 1. At its 44th meeting, on 22 November 1983, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/50) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/38/L.17. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/38/L.17, an additional appropriation of \$110,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.
