"WE HAVE LEARNT OF SUBSTANCE OF LETTER (S/3865 and Add.1) SENT BY ARAB REPRESENTATIVES ON BEHALF OF CERTAIN ARAB COUNTRIES REQUESTING CONVENING OF SECURITY COUNCIL MEETING TO INTERFERE IN AFFAIRS OF OUR COUNTRY. WE HEREBY BRING TO YOUR NOTICE OUR FORMAL PROTEST AGAINST PROPOSALS CONTAINED IN THE SAID LETTER AND INVITE YOUR ATTENTION TO FACT THAT MATTERS TO WHICH LETTER RELATES FALL EXCLUSIVELY WITHIN OUR INTERNAL JURISDICTION AND ARE NO CONCERN OF UNITED NATIONS ORGANIZATION.
