II. Comments received from Governments

India

[Original: English]

First preambular paragraph

1. At the end of the last line, the words “the world crime problem,” should be replaced with the words “crime and seek justice,”.

Operative paragraph 4

2. In the last line, the word “undertaken” should be added after the word “counter-measures”.

Operative paragraph 5

3. The first sentence of operative paragraph 5 should read: “We are convinced that upholding the rule of law and good governance at the national and international level are critical to the creation of an environment for successfully tackling crime.”
4. At the end of the last sentence of the same operative paragraph, the words “in particular at the local level” should be replaced with the words “at all levels”.

Operative paragraph 8

5. In the first sentence, the words “seek to” should be inserted between the words “so to” and “ratify”.

Operative paragraph 12

6. The words “the protection of” should be replaced by the words “trafficking in”.

Operative paragraph 14

7. The words “commit ourselves to strengthening” should be replaced with the words “endeavour to strengthen”.

Operative paragraph 16

8. In the second sentence, the word “, regional” should be inserted after the word “multilateral”.

Operative paragraph 17

9. The operative paragraph should be amended to read as follows:

“17. We call upon Member States to conclude as soon as possible the ongoing negotiation of the draft comprehensive convention on international terrorism and we welcome the adoption by the General Assembly of the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism.”

Operative paragraph 18

10. The operative paragraph should be amended to read:

“18. We welcome the United Nations Convention against Corruption,
which is central to the efforts at the international level to fight corruption.”
