CABLE DATED 2 SEPTEMBER 1965 FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN  
AFFAIRS OF SINGAPORE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On behalf of the State of Singapore and in my capacity as Minister for Foreign Affairs have the honour to inform you that the sovereign State of Singapore, having attained independence, wishes herewith to make application for membership of the United Nations with all the rights and duties attached thereto stop

By solemn proclamations dated 9 August 1965 by the Prime Ministers of Singapore and Malaysia, Singapore which was a constituent State of Malaysia, was declared an independent, sovereign State and was recognized as such by the Government of Malaysia stop

I should accordingly be grateful if this application could be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting stop For this purpose, I am sending by separate telegram a declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the Council's rules of procedure stop

A formal instrument will follow in due course stop
