REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE INCREASE
IN THE NUMBER OF UNITED NATIONS OBSERVATION POSTS AND
MILITARY OBSERVERS IN THE ISRAEL-LEBANON SECTOR

Addendum

1. In his report of 22 February 1973 concerning the increase in the number of United Nations observation posts and military observers in the Israel-Lebanon sector (S/10824/Add.1), the Secretary-General informed the Security Council of two recommendations made in this connexion by the Chief of Staff of UNTSO, Major-General Ensio Siilasvuo. The Secretary-General also indicated his intention to put General Siilasvuo's recommendations into effect not later than 15 March 1973. Subsequently he agreed, in response to a request from the President of the Security Council, to postpone the proposed action until the end of March.
2. By a letter dated 30 March (S/10907), the President of the Security Council informed the Secretary-General that he had held consultations with members of the Council on the matter raised in the Secretary-General's report of 22 February. The members of the Council, referring to their consensus of 19 April 1972 (S/10611), had no objection to the Secretary-General's putting into effect General Siilasvuo's recommendations.
3. On 30 March, the Secretary-General took the necessary action to provide UNTSO with four additional Finnish observers and four field service officers.
