Addendum

- 1. The Chief Officer of UNIFOM, General B.F. MacDonald, reports that, as of 5 October, eighty Observers have assumed their duties with UNIFOM. On the Pakistan side, nine are serving as headquarters staff at Lahore, and thirty have been deployed in other localities in the UNIFOM area of operations. On the India side, four have been assigned as headquarters staff at Amritsar and thirty-seven have been deployed in other localities.
- 2. General MacDonald also advises that as UNIFOM Observers have been deployed and have established working contact with local commanders, there has been a noticeable improvement in the situation along the line.
