Press communiqué, issued on 6 February 1989, of the meeting of the Ministers, Members of the Co-ordinating Committee on Defense of the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea

On 6 February 1989, His Excellency Mr. Son Sen, His Excellency Mr. Im Choodeth and His Royal Highness Prince Norodom Chakrapong, Ministers, Members of the Co-ordinating Committee on Defense of the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea (CGDK), held a very cordial meeting in order to make an assessment of the situation of the struggle waged by the three patriotic forces and the people of Kampuchea against the Vietnamese aggressors, especially the situation on the battlefield.

The meeting:

1. Has expressed once again the full support of the decision of the Council of Ministers of the CGDK that has pointed out the vital importance of the close co-operation in all fields, military, political and diplomatic, among the CGDK's three parties;
2. Has also reiterated the full support of the National Sihanoukian Army (ANS), the KPLNF Army and the National Army of Democratic Kampuchea (NADK) to the 5-point peace plan of His Royal Highness Samdech Norodom Sihanouk;
3. Has noted with satisfaction the increasing co-operation among the three patriotic armed forces in many fronts on the battlefield in conformity with the past decision of the CGDK Council of Ministers;
4. Has adopted a number of new measures aimed at facilitating further that co-operation in the fighting against the Vietnamese aggressors during the current dry season inside Kampuchea as well as at the western border areas;
5. Would like to call on the three armed forces of the CGDK and the whole Kampuchean people to increase their activities against the Vietnamese aggressors with a view to actively contributing to the search of a political solution to the problem of Kampuchea on the basis of the 5-point peace plan of His Royal Highness Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, the Leader of the Khmer Nation.
