**Official communiqué of the 5483rd (closed) meeting  
of the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,  
11 July 2006, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5483rd meeting, held in private on 11 July 2006, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Georgia’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Georgia and Germany to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The Speaker of the Parliament of Georgia, Her Excellency Mrs. Nino Burjanadze, made a statement.

“The representative of the Russian Federation made a statement.”
