DRAFT INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND  
MEASURES OF IMPLEMENTATION

United States of America:

Proposal on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights

Each State party hereto undertakes to promote conditions of economic, social and cultural progress and development for a higher standard of life in larger freedom for all, with due regard to the organization and resources of the State; and to co-operate for effective international action in economic, social and cultural matters with organs of the United Nations and with specialized agencies established by inter-governmental agreement and brought into relationship with the United Nations under the provisions of the Charter of the United Nations.
