HUMAN RIGHTS AND MEASURES OF IMPLEMENTATION

France: Proposal for a general clause concerning economic, social and cultural rights

The States parties to the present Covenant,

- 1. bearing in mind the link between the rights and liberties recognized and defined above, and the economic, social and cultural rights proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights;
- 2. resolved to combat the scourges, such as famine, disease, poverty, the feeling of insecurity and ignorance, which take toll of or degrade men, prevent the free development of their personality;
- 3. resolved to strive to ensure that every human being shall obtain the food, clothing and shelter essential for his livelihood and well-being, and shall achieve an adequate standard of living and a continuous improvement of his living material and spiritual conditions;
- 4. undertake to take steps, individually and through international co-operation, to the maximum of the available resources with a view to achieving progressively the full realization of the rights recognized in this part of the Covenant.
